The 'already' ...

1) Love for God and for others:

"This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands. In fact, this is love for God: to keep his commands."

2) Faith:

"By faith, Noah ... obeyed ... By faith, Abraham ... obeyed"

Hebrews 11:7,8

3) Worship:

"Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God – this is your true and proper worship."

4) Testimony, blessing, safety, wisdom, ...
